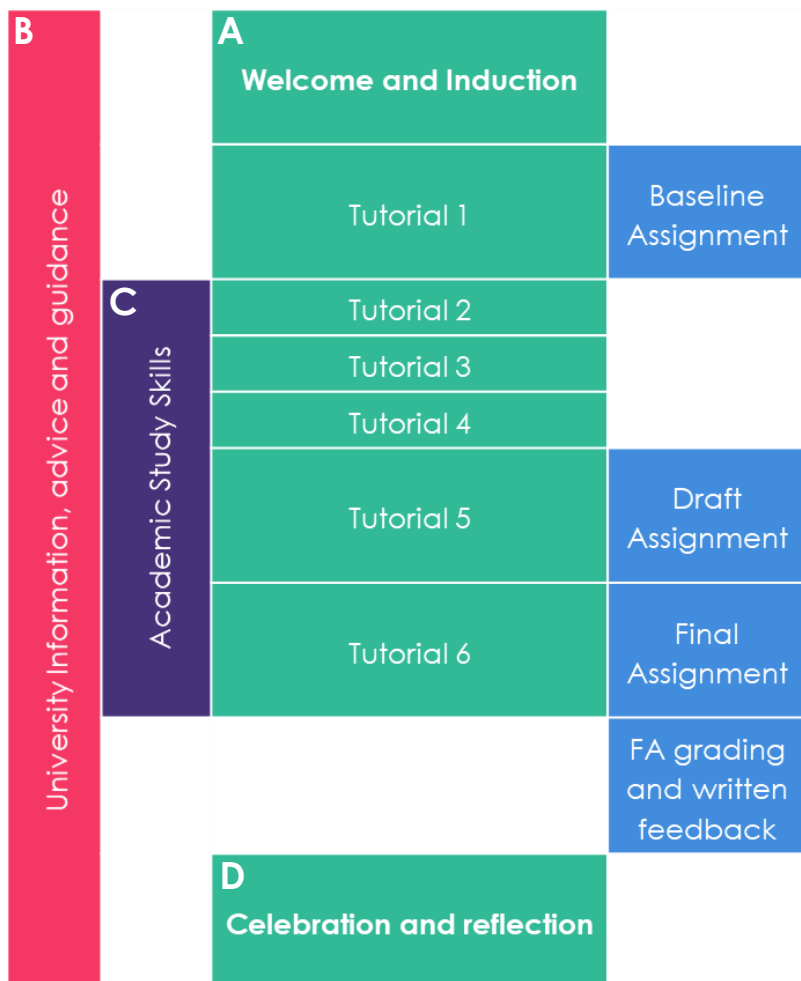




Virtual TSP Programme Outline

The example below details the structure of the virtual programme alongside additional University information advice and guidance and study skills sessions provided by The Brilliant Club and Scholars Programme tutors.



A. Welcome resources are provided for schools to launch programme with pupils at a time convenient to them.

B. University advice and guidance will have both live and recorded resources for pupils to access during the programme.

Materials will be age specific will include, sessions such as:

- Campus tour videos
- Personal statement writing
- Things I wish I knew before going to university
- Why I chose my university and course
- Managing your finances
- How to show subject passion
- I know what I want to study – how do I know where to study it?
- Transition to university
- Applying for university – using UCAS effectively
- Live Student Ambassador Q &A sessions
- Live Parent information sessions (during campus closures)
- Live teacher information sessions (during campus closures)

C. Study skills sections will be embedded into tutorial 2-6. The content for these will be provided by The Brilliant Club but will be adapted delivered by PhD Tutors based on their subject expertise. Sessions could include: *How to be a good researcher, Source Analysis, Referencing and plagiarism, Time Management and effective planning for writing a final assignment and Writing a good final assignment*

D. Celebration and Reflection

We will provide resources that can be used at a time convenient for the school to bring the programme to a close and celebrate pupils' hard work. These resources would include:

- Certificates
- Template assembly presentations
- Messages and feedback from their tutor

There would also be synchronous delivery of a virtual 'graduation' ceremony which pupils, teachers and parents can access.
