They will:

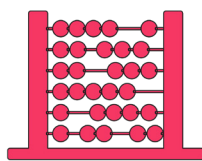
- Gain **valuable teaching** and **public engagement** experience

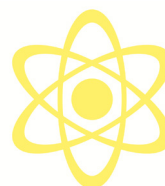
