WHY DO YOU RUN THE PROGRAMME AT YOUR SCHOOL?

We were one of the first schools to engage in the NTP with 90 places secured with the Brilliant Club to start in January. We also had 45 places with a different provider before Christmas. We are a secondary school in a deprivation area with around 65% of our students living in IDACI deciles 1 to 4. We have 40% PP and 26% FSM. These students needed the catch up funding to provide additional support.

HOW DID YOU SELECT WHICH PUPILS WOULD TAKE PART?

Students were selected based on forecast grades from Spring 2020 vs Autumn 2020 in order to see how their progress had been hindered through the first lockdown. We prioritised core subjects and sub-categories of Pupil Premium, Free School Meals and IDACI decile and low income. We decided not to use Year 7 and focused on Years 8 to 11.

WHAT OUTCOMES HAVE YOU SEEN FOR THE PUPILS TAKING PART?

I have seen students elated after a lesson. The praise and confidence building that some tutors have offered has been excellent. Many students enjoy the tutorials and I am sure that many would like them to continue. I like the fact that there has been little change in the tutor as our students need consistency and trust to build.
