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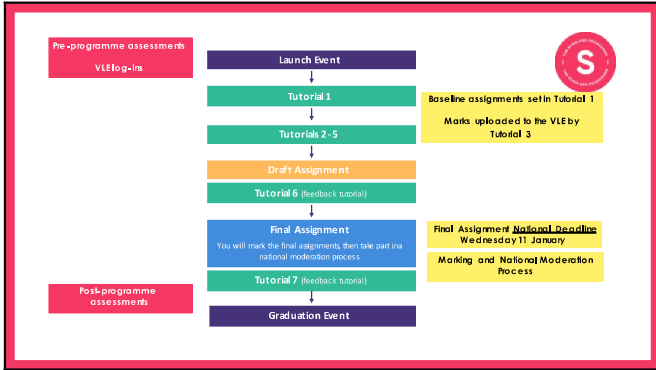
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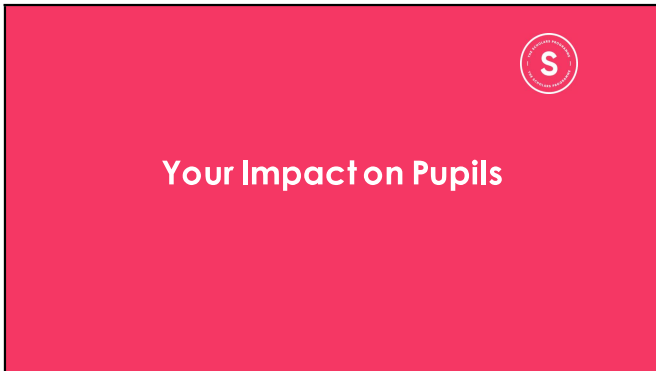
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**The Scholars Programme – its working!**

- Progression to postgraduate study and destination measures

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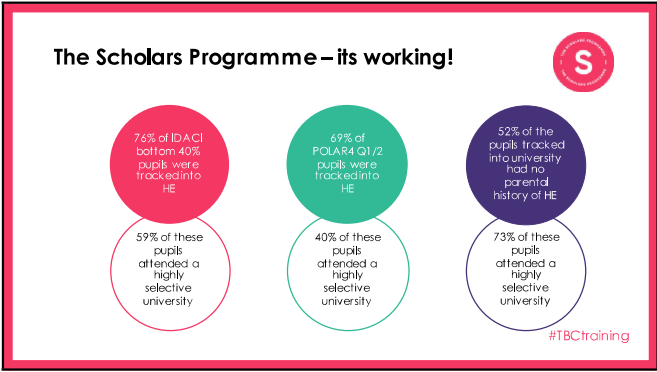
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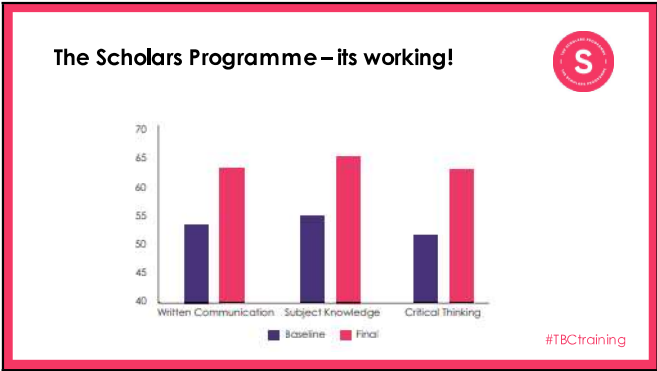
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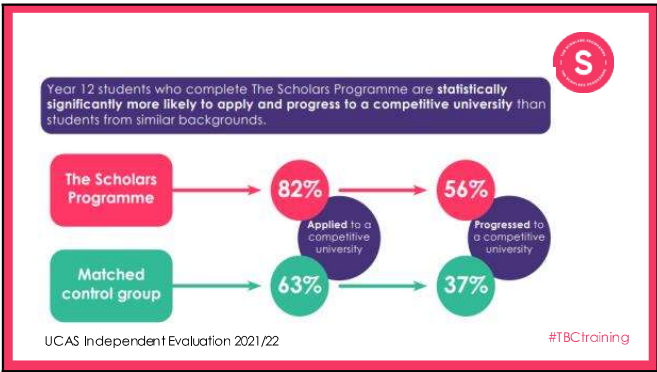
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**For Year 12 Students specifically...**

Out of the Scholars Programme graduates who applied to university, **9 in 10** applied to a competitive university.

**1 in 2** students eligible for Pupil Premium who graduated from The Scholars Programme progressed to a competitive university.

Scholars Programme graduates, including those eligible for Pupil Premium, apply to Oxbridge at **more than double the rate** of their peers from similar backgrounds.

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
