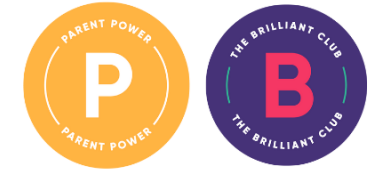


# Parent Power - Theory of Change

## Inputs

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An anchor institution that hosts events and provides higher education expertise

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Trained organiser from the local community



## Activities



### Relational one-to-one meetings

Between parents and community organisers

### Group meetings

Held every 6 weeks, focused on:

- Learning about higher education
- Developing community organising skills
- Building campaigns to fight against educational inequality



## Outputs



Parents lead campaigns to secure support, resources and opportunities that will help their children access higher education



## Outcomes



### Community leaders

Parents develop skills in leadership and community organising

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### Engaged with education

Parents increase their confidence to support their children's education

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### Higher education champions

Parents have the knowledge to act as higher education champions in their community
