1. Parent Power Meetings

2. Information and Guidance

Parents in Norwich Parent Power have received information and guidance sessions on study skills and choosing GCSE options. They have also received support on how to open-up conversations with their young people through NEACO's 'Curious Questions' game.

3. Local Campaigns

Parents are currently working on a campaign for a bespoke open day at the UEA. Parents are also working on developing a campaign around supporting their young people with study stress.
