## Birmingham Parent Power Activities

### 1. Group Meetings

Parents/carers attend meetings every 6 weeks to receive information and guidance to support their child's education journey. Topics have included student finance, course choices, and super-curricular activities.

### 2. Community Listening

Deep community listening is a key step in the cycle of social change. In our community listening in Birmingham, key themes have emerged about the disparity of opportunities across the city, including unfair access to work experience. This has resulted in the group securing a bespoke industry visit, due to take place in Summer 2026.
